Illawarra District Netball Association welcomes all teams and umpires to the 2023 Senior Indoor Competition.

RULES OF COMPETITION – SENIOR INDOOR

A – REGISTRATION OF TEAMS

- Team contacts are to register the team via the PlayHQ - <https://www.playhq.com/netball-australia/register/1eccf4> by the required date. For each competition. Dates listed below
- Team contacts must be over the age of 18 and have a valid email and phone number to receive correspondence. Contacts do not have to be a player of the team.
- Teams will have the option of nominating for Women Competition, Social or Mixed Competitions.
- Once team nominations have closed the team contact will be contacted to confirm the night they have been accepted to play on.
- The team contact will also be provided with a team link to forward to all players to register to their team.
- Teams will be required to pay court fees of \$60 each week via EFT/Cash (one payment per team)
- A Team nomination fee of \$20 is required to be paid on nominating.

B – REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- All players must be registered via Playhq to play in each competition.
- Players will be sent a link to register (from their team contact) and this must be completed by the required closing date.
- All players must be turning 14 years of age in the year of play.
- Players can register for 12months.
- The registration fee is the Netball NSW component that is paid once at the time of registration for either indoor or outdoor competitions.
- Additional registration fees will be charged for the outdoor competition.
- Players are only allowed to register in one team only on any night except where mixed and women's is played on the same night.

C – GRADING

- Teams will be graded based on the information provided on the nomination form as well as previous competition results.
- Depending on the number of teams that nominate – teams will be split into grades.

D – UMPIRES

- Umpires must be of at least 15years of age.
- Umpires must hold a district badge.
- Umpires will be offered coaching.
- Umpires will be allocated by Lauren Hawkins.
- Umpires can wear white or black shorts/skirt or track pants with a white top.
- Umpires must bring their own whistle.
- Umpires will be paid \$15 Per game

E – COMPETITION RULES

General

- Games will be played according to the IFNA Netball rules with uniform exceptions.
- Games will be centrally timed, and a hooter will sound one minute prior to starting time when all players and umpires must take the court.
- The games will be 2 x 16minute halves with a 3minute break at half time.
- A hooter will sound for the commencement, half time and conclusion of games.
- Game times will be rotating time slots from 6pm – 8.40pm for night competition for Senior
- Competitions will be 15wks + 2wks for finals

- Mixed teams are allowed to have no more than 3 males on the court at any time during the game. 2 Males are unable to be in the circle positions. At least 1 male must be always on the court.
- All court fees must be paid on the night.

Uniforms

- All players can wear club uniform or appropriate shorts/tights/leggings and t-shirt or tank top.
- No Jewellery is to be worn during the game.
- Nails must be cut short; gloves can be worn.

Substitutions

- No injury time is permitted. If an injury occurs, play is stopped, the injury is assessed, and the player is removed from the court.
- Substitutions are allowed only during an interval or in the event of an injury or illness.

Borrowing of players

- Teams may borrow up to a maximum of 3 players per game.
- Late Registered players must be received by 12pm on the day of the game.
- All borrowed players must be registered in playhq.
- Teams playing illegal players will be notified and fines will incur.

Forfeits

- Any team wishing to forfeit a game must notify the Competition Contact prior to 12pm on the day of the game for a Notified forfeit.
- Fines for forfeits are \$60 notified - \$70 unnotified.
- All fines must be paid before the next game.
- If five (5) players of a team are not present within five (5) minutes of starting time a forfeit may be claimed.

Points

- 2 points for a win.
- 1 point for a draw.
- 0 points for a loss.
- 2 points for receiving a forfeit.
- 0 points for giving a forfeit.

Scoresheets

- Scoresheets will be printed for all teams to record what players are playing.
- Borrowed players must be written on the scoresheet.

Finals

- Players must have played at least 4 games to qualify for finals.
- Players are only eligible to play in finals with the team that they are registered for.
- Finals will be played over 2 weeks, Finals, Grand Finals.
- Winners and Runners up will receive a gift.

Complaints

- All complaints must come through the team contact and be sent to Illawarra by 2pm the day following the game.
- All complaints must be on the appropriate incident form.
- All complaints will be responded to in a timely manner.
- Complaints regarding behaviour will be dealt with under Regulation 4 of the IDNA Regulations in conjunction with Netball NSW Code of Behaviour.
